

## CAPOEIRA4REFUGEES (C4R) – JOB DESCRIPTION

<b>Title:</b>	<b>Assistant Capoeira Trainer</b>
<b>Overview:</b>	Since its founding in 2007 in Damascus, Syria, Capoeira4Refugees (C4R) has worked with children and youth in conflict zones. C4R uses capoeira, a 16th century afro-brazilian art form which incorporates music, sport and play, to improve the lives of children and youth affected by conflict. C4R currently has community-based and camp-based programs in Jordan and also supports capoeira trainers and their initiatives in Turkey, Palestine, and Syria in an effort to encourage and equip the greater capoeira community in the Middle East. <b>Contract duration:</b>	Start Date <b>ASAP</b>
<b>Tenure:</b>	Minimum 3 days per week for a minimum of 6 months. 1 month probation period.
<b>Location:</b>	Based at Capoeira4Refugees headquarters in Amman, Jordan with travel to program locations throughout Jordan.
<b>Responsible to</b>	Head Trainer, Programme Manager
<b>Benefits:</b>	No pay or allowances; reference letter upon completion
<p><b>Role Overview:</b>  This is a hands-on role, where the trainer must show initiative and be able to work closely with and learn from our current trainers in order to deliver successful programmes to our beneficiaries and partners. You will build strong relationships with your students to support them in benefitting from the capoeira classes. Independent actions could include finding venues for training, advertising of classes, engaging volunteers, taking photos of the classes for marketing purposes, using social media to manage and build a community, capture stories and information from the projects. The success of the role will depend on your own resourcefulness, hard work, and inspiration.</p>	
<p><b>1. Purpose of the Position:</b>  The role will provide support to Head Trainers in leading classes for vulnerable young refugees using social capoeira; and to identify and support talented youth to become assistant trainers so that they can support their own communities.</p>

Responsibilities:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Assist in the implementation of capoeira training sessions according to C4R's guidelines</li> <li>● Attend training programmes as scheduled by the Programme Manager</li> <li>● Support Capoeira Teachers in planning and implementing workshops, performances and events according to the programme goals and milestones.</li> <li>● Ensure that all relevant data required from each class, workshop or event is accurately recorded according to the C4R monitoring and evaluation guidelines</li> </ul>
